

Invasive Plant Control Program

DID YOU KNOW?

Funded through Sustainable CAP, SARM administers a cost-share rebate program **available to producers, RMs and First Nations** to assist with costs to control prohibited weeds and specific noxious weeds.

2024-25 INVASIVE PLANT CONTROL PROGRAM will rebate:

- **50%** for pre-approved eligible herbicides and application costs for all prohibited weeds
- **Up to 50%** for pre-approved eligible herbicides only on specific noxious weeds outlined in the IPCP Appendix A.
- **Up to 50% (RMs and FNs only)** for appointed Weed Inspector expenses related to monitoring and eligible training events from January 1 – October 31, 2024

HOW TO CLAIM by OCTOBER 31, 2024

- **RMs must appoint and First Nations must authorize an individual as Weed Inspector as per *The Weed Control Act***
 - Completed herbicide claim forms, invoices and herbicide application records must be submitted through your RM or First Nation office to be signed by the administrator before the claim deadline.
 - RMs and First Nations submit all herbicide claim packages, Weed Inspector expense claims and Weed Management Plans to SARM by October 31, 2024.
